Developmental Math Reform Status Report, August-September 2015

Achievements in this period

The team has met four times during this period. Of those meetings, two have been with Dibyen Majumdar, and one with Nikos Varelas.

A draft of a proposal for adding Math 110, College Algebra, Math 089, a Co-Requisite course for Math 090, and curriculum changes for Math 090 and Math 121 was written. This draft includes data that was gathered to support these changes.

Key Decisions

The determination of what courses to add and their content, and where to place the co-requisite courses, as well as potential placement cut-offs for the adjusted and new courses.

Goals for next period:

The draft will be circulated throughout several departments, informing them of the proposed changes, and to initiate discussions about how this could potentially affect their courses, providing necessary feedback before finalizing the proposal.

The course descriptions will be expanded into formal syllabi, and the proposal will be finalized and submitted, along with necessary forms to institute the changes.

Open Issues:

Determine the structure of the new courses. Look into class size, active learning, blended classrooms, etc.
